WORD BUILDERS

How to use the word builder cards:

Goal: To develop a learner's ability to read words with a variety of sound-spelling patterns of increasing difficulty.

Literacy Skills: Phonemic Awareness - Sound Blending
Letter-Sound Recognition

Instructions:

- Model by tapping each square under the letter while you say the sound, then move your finger along the arrow to blend and read the word.
- Adult says: "Now its your turn. You tap each square, say the sounds without stopping, then read the word."
- After reading words, learner can be asked to spell words.
