Many language learners long for the fun that comes from human interaction. No bells & whistles are needed-only you, as a caregiver! People games are simple, repetive routines such as peek-a-boo. They use movement, touch, sound or music to motivate authentic communication. As your child becomes familiar with these predictable routines, they will take more turns and make requests to play again! These can be used as verbal routines, so as you do these games a few times, pause and wait for your child to finish the practiced message e.g., 1, 2, 3.... up.
